2 Kings 6:24-7:2

1. Be aware that Satan desires for you to blame God and believe that He has abandoned you.

³My tears have been my food day and night, while they say to me all the day long, "Where is your God?" ¹⁰As with a deadly wound in my bones, my adversaries taunt me, while they say to me all the day long, "Where is your God?"
